

COOPERATIVE LEARNING/TEACHING PERIODE 3

Year 2/3 and Year 5

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→ COOPERATIVE WORKSHOPS

Year 2 and 3 and Year 5 pupils are mingled and work in groups of 5 or 6 => 10 teams (named from A to J)

5 workshops duplicated in each classroom – 5 weeks rotation + 1 final session

The door between the 2 classrooms stays open so that the 2 teachers can go everywhere and support cooperation in every team.

Workshop 1 : Challenge : build a house

Pupils have to build a house with what they have on the table (colour papers, glue, tape, plastic square). They need to agree on the plan and to divide the tasks.



Workshop 2 : Cooperative games

1 Vocabulary game (anagrams) : 1 pupil pick a word and the others have to find anagrams

1 game about Europe created by Year 5 pupils : Year 5 pupils teach the younger how to play



Workshop 3 : Write a letter

Pupils, in groups of 2 or 3, have to write a letter to present our school to ERASMUS partners (Spain, Hungary and Italy).



Workshop 4 : escape game (mathematics)

Each team has to find 8 envelopes hidden in the classroom. Inside, there are 8 enigmas they have to solve to discover the 3-digit code that open the safe-deposit box.



Workshop 5 : Roll a Picasso (Art)

Pupils roll the dice and draw the appropriate part to create portraits in the style of Pablo Picasso, then they pass their drawing to their left-hand neighbour. After rolling the dice 6 times, everyone has a complete portrait, made by the whole group, and can color it (oil pastel and paint).
